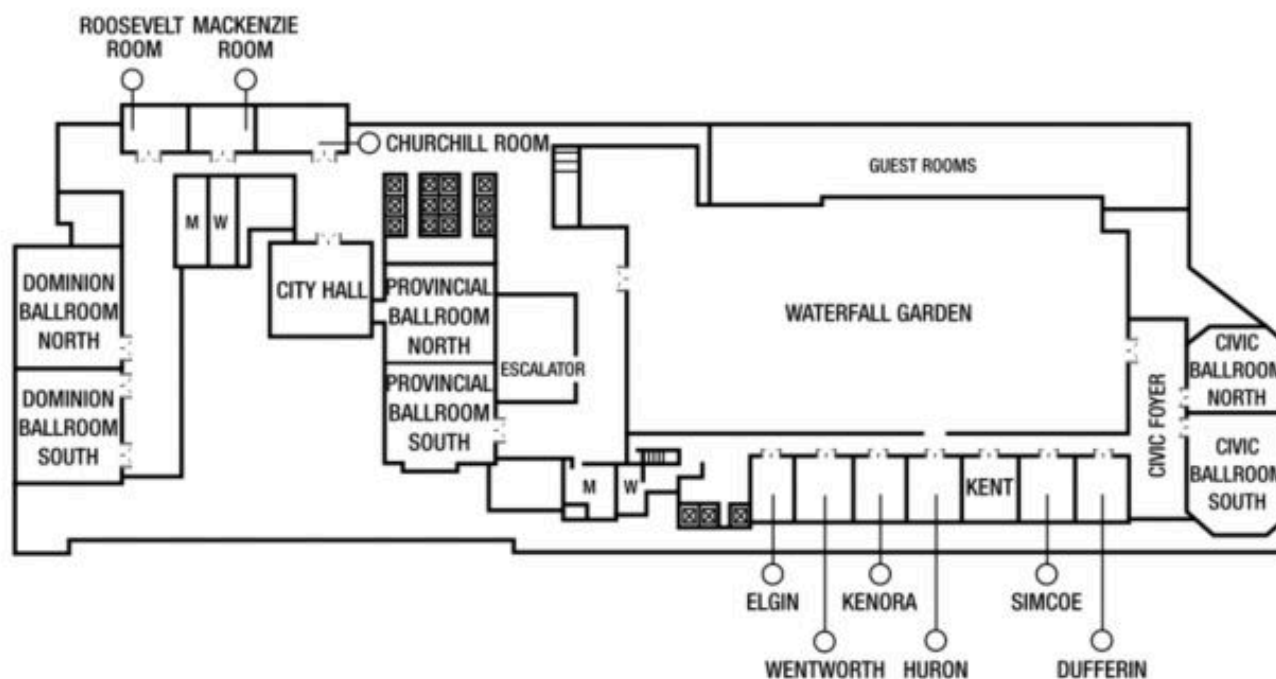

## Behavior

In the event a delegate performs any illegal/improper activity that breaches regional, provincial or national law, their guardians/faculty advisors will not only be contacted but they may also be reported to authorities, and shall immediately be expelled from the conference.

## Delegate Report System

During the conference, delegates may contact a member of the equity team through completing the online equity form or by contacting the Delegate assistance desk located at the **CIVIC FOYER**. When submitting the form, delegates have the option to remain anonymous. Please find the equity form via the CANMUN website under “Resources - - Equity -- Report It”.
